What is the Flag Program

- Committee of El Cajon area community members
 - Patriotic citizens
 - BSA 362, Rotary, Elks, City of El Cajon, Lions Club, Kiwanis
- Formed shortly after 9/11 to honor our nation's flag and to raise awareness of patriotism
- ~180 American flags placed along Main Street on special occasions
- To honor individuals with plaques on flag poles



Honoring America and our Flag

- The Committee raises awareness and funds to sustain the program
 - Flag poles, flags, pole holders materials, storage, insurance
- Boy Scouts of America Troop #362
 - Maintains/fixes poles, sidewalks, flags
 - Sets up and takes down flags on days of celebration
- Flag typically displayed 7-8 times a year:
 - Veterans Day, Fourth of July, Flag Day, Memorial Day, El Cajon's America on Main Street, etc.

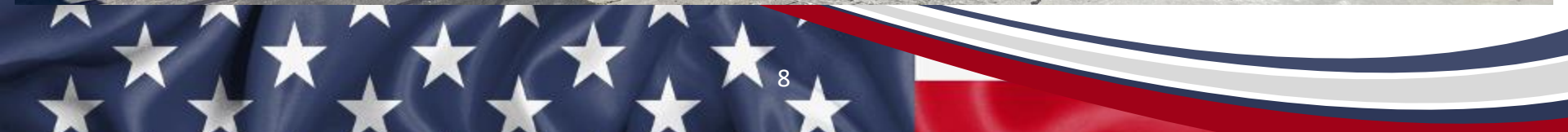


Flags on Display
